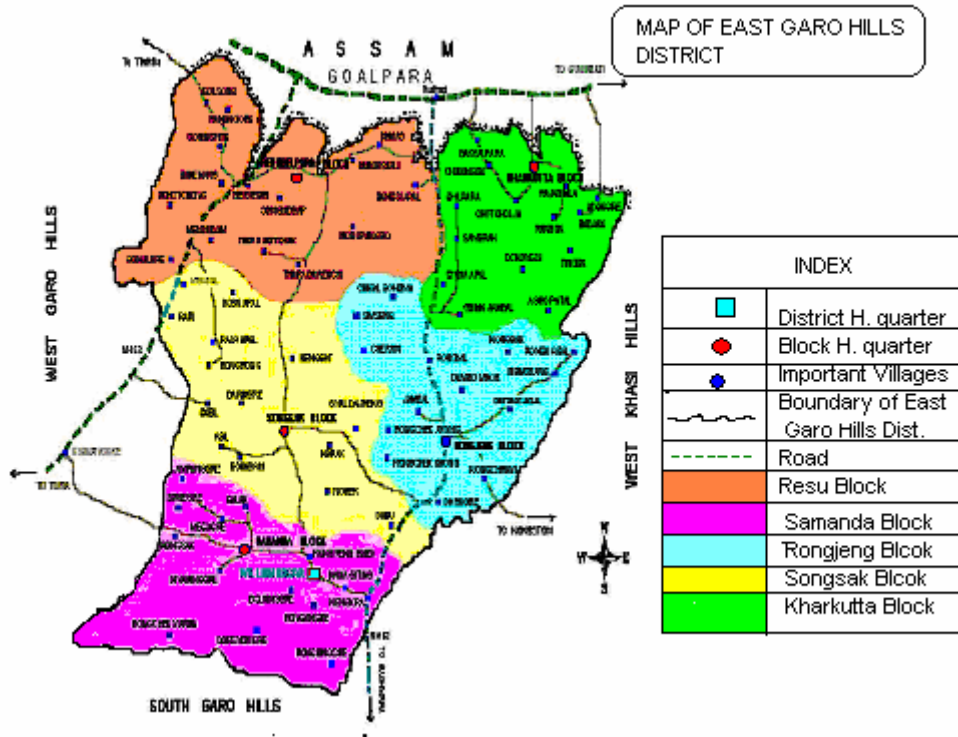

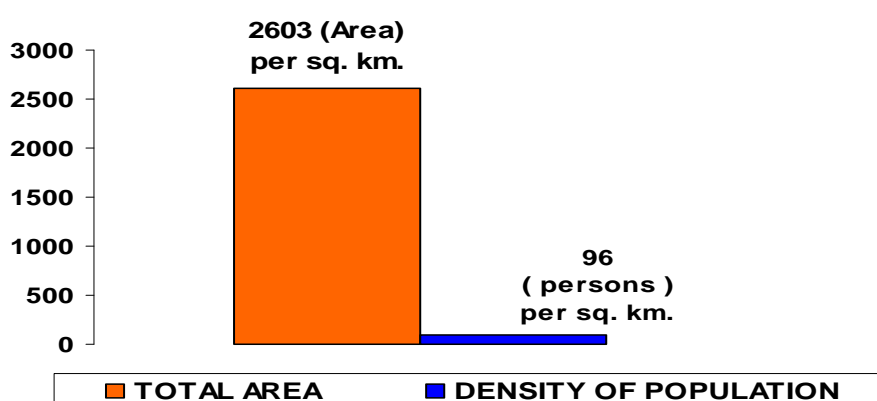

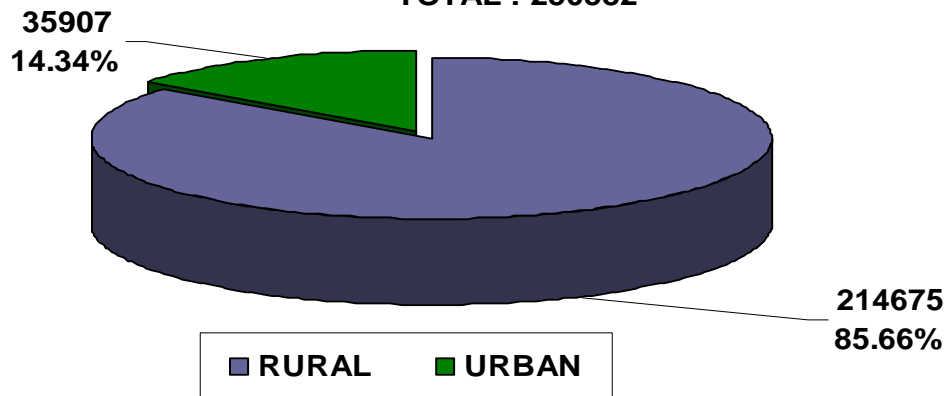

(per sq. km.), 2001**



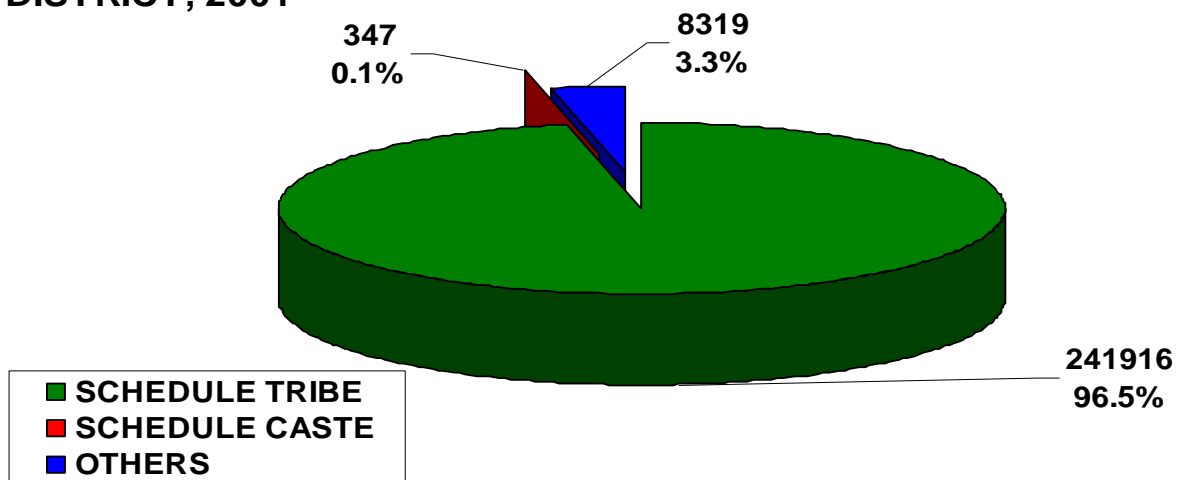

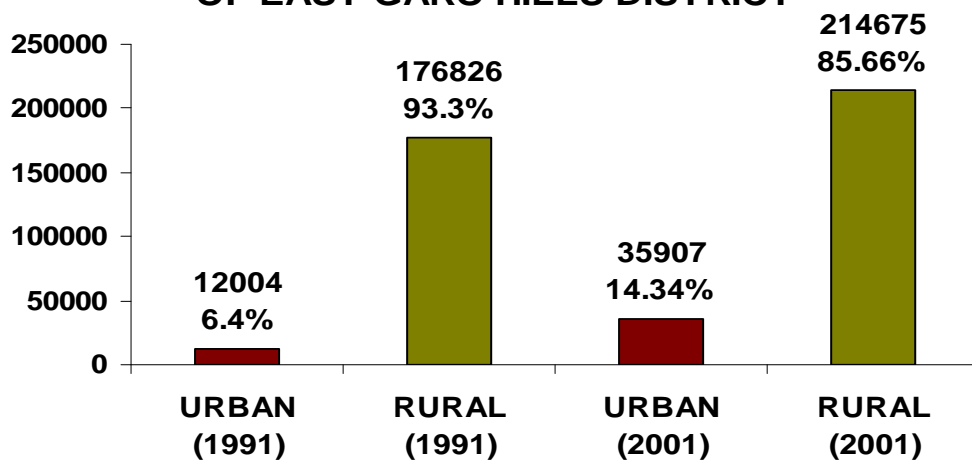

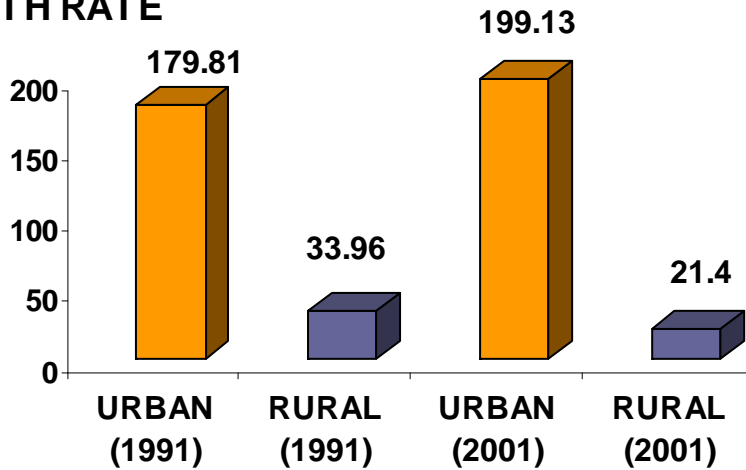
**SCHEDULE TRIBE, SCHEDULE CASTE & OTHERS

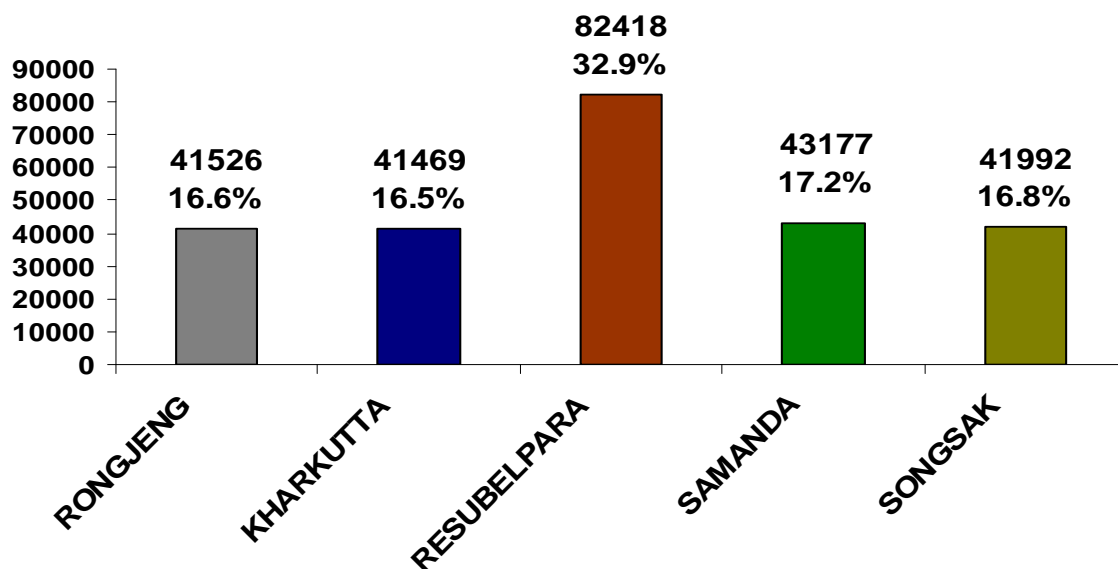

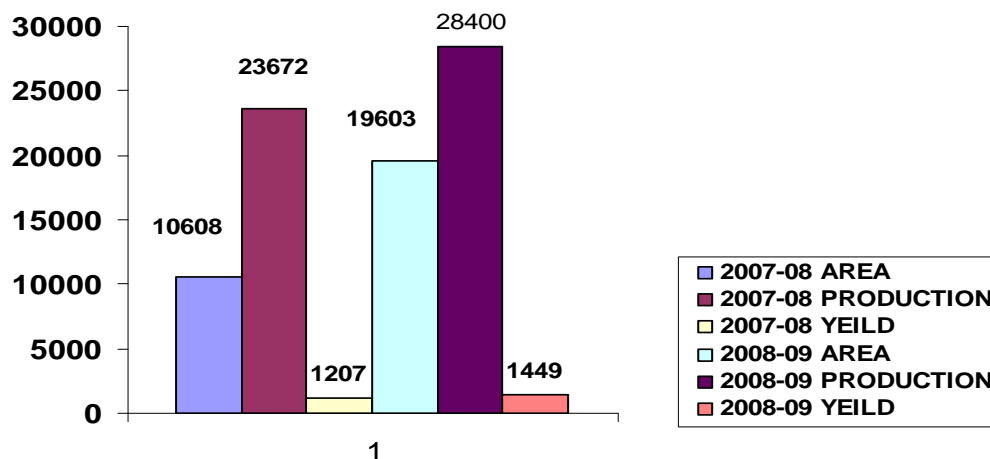

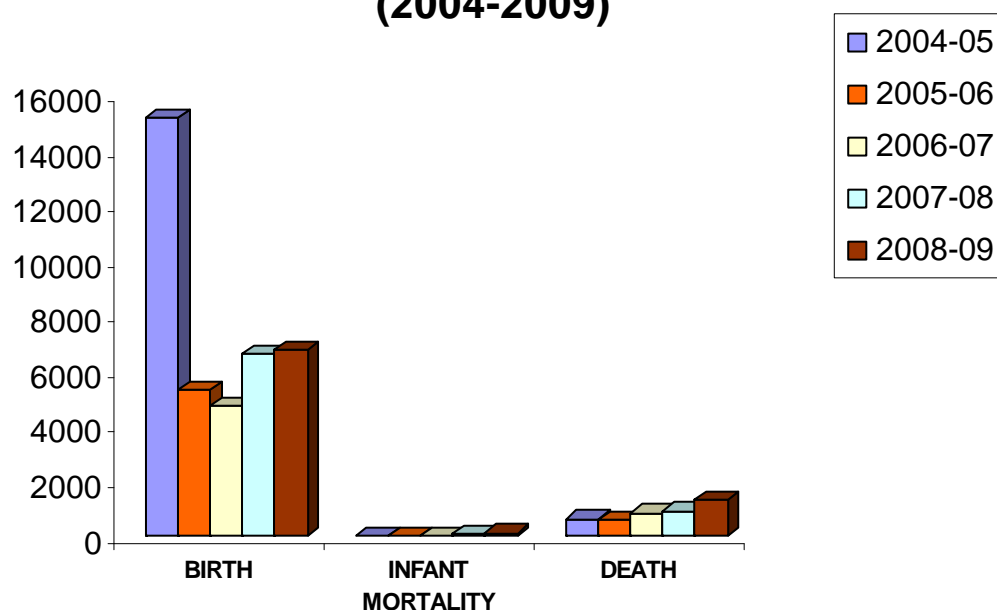
