I deem it a great privilege to participate in the 59th meeting of the NEC here in New Delhi. I have completed 5(five) months only at the helm. I bring greetings of the people of Meghalaya to you Sir, and the House as a whole. I look forward to the deliberations from all the participating Ministries and member States of the NEC and hope, that, by the end of the day, some concrete decisions would be taken by the Council which would generate far reaching benefits to the people of the North Eastern Region.

2. Transmission of Power:

Meghalaya's generation of power is 186.70 MW only. Its share of power from the Central Utilities in the East and North East Regions is 200 MW. Hence, the existing power availability from own generation and Central Power Sector share is 386.70 MW. However, due to transmission constraints, the power that can presently
