- 2. The Cell is required to provide its view within 7 working days of the receiving of grievance.
- 3. Reach mutually agreed solutions satisfactory to both the project and the affected person including scheduled tribes and resolve any project-related grievance locally, in consultation with the aggrieved party.
- 4. Facilitate the smooth implementation of the social and environmental plan and prevent delay in project implementation.
- 5. Democratize the development process at the local level, while maintaining transparency and establishing accountability to the scheduled tribes.
- 6. Facilitate effective dialogue and open communication between the project stakeholders.
- 7. Clearly define the roles and responsibilities of the various parties involved in the consideration and resolution of grievances
