Grant-in-Aid (Plan/Non-Recurring) to Construction of RCC Bridge over river Lunar to Sub: connect Khaddum to Brichyrnot Village, East Jaintia Hills, Meghalaya for Hmar Community for financial year 2021-22 under Scheme of NEC under MH-2552(35), funding under 30% deprived/neglected areas.

Secretary, NEC in exercise of the financial powers delegated by the Government of India, Ministry of DoNER vide letter No. 4/1/2010-DoNER(NEC) dtd. 7th September, 2012& OM No. 1/1/2014-DoNER(NEC) dated 26th November, 2014 has accorded Administrative Approval towards the proposal Construction of RCC Bridge over river Lunar to connect Khaddum to Brichyrnot Village, East Jaintia Hills, Meghalaya for Hmar Community for an estimated cost of Rs. 490.62 lakhs (Rupees Four Hundred Ninety Lakhs & Sixty Two Thousand) only to be implemented by the Deputy Commissioner, East Jaintia District, Meghalaya. The funding is under Major Head"2552/35.

This Administrative Approval is issue subject to the following conditions:-2.

The assets/facilities created for the above studies out of Government Grant will not be a)

transferred/sold /alienated without the approval of NEC and Ministry of DoNER, Government

The Deputy Commissioner, East Jaintia Hills District, Meghalaya shall ensure proper b) upkeep, maintenance and operation of the assets/facilities created out of the project.

The objective/methodologies as outlined in the above sanctioned proposal shall be strictly c) followed for implementation. There should not be any duplication of efforts/studies already made for the similar works.

A management committee should be constituted under the Chairmanship of DC East Jaintia d) Hills a member from the State Planning Department and State PWD, (Road) Govt. of Meghalaya for effective management of the infrastructure supported by NEC.

The facility should be open to the general public

e) Monitoring of the project will be done by the NEC and State Planning Department, Govt. of f). Meghalaya

The GPS co-ordinates of project site shall be communicated to NEC

g) The work must be executed by inviting e-tender as per Rule 160 of GFR-2017 and a copy of h) the e-tender notice along with detail work order/contact agreement to be submitted to NEC within 7 (seven) days of finalization of the contact.

The detail particulars/scope of work/specification etc of the work/project is as per the detail 3. Project Proposal received from Deputy Commissioner, East Jaintia Hills Meghalaya and are as follows:

- 4. NEC will release funds in 2 (two) instalments subject to availability of funds in the budget (40% and 60%. Initially at the time of issuance of Administrative and financial sanction, a token amount of Rs. 10.00 lakhs (Rupees ten lakhs) would be released by NEC as part payment of the 1st instalment so that the tender formalities could be initiated and finalised by the implementing agency. Thereafter the implementing agency will approach NEC with a copy of work order, updated EAT report and letter for claiming the release of the balance amount of 1st instalment.
- (a) Second instalment of the project will be released by the NEC once the State Government mandatorily summit utilization certificate for 75% of the first instalment released and commensurate physical progress duly signed by the Head of designated agency and countersigned by Planning Secretary of the State Government.
- (b) The progress report and utilization certificate must also indicate the share of contribution of the State Govt. if any for the project. All these utilization certificates and progress reports should be sent to the NEC with the counter signature of the Secretary Planning, Govt. of Meghalaya.
- 5. The Deputy Commissioner, East Jaintia Hills District, Meghalaya would submit the quarterly physical & financial progress report and financial expenditure reports in the prescribed proforma of NEC to the Financial Adviser, Economic Adviser (E&M) and the Director (HRD&E), NEC Sectt, Shillong by the 15th of next month following each quarter. It will be opened to NEC & DoNER to monitor the progress of work as and when considered necessary.
- 6. NEC's funding for the above scheme should be acknowledged by way of prominently displaying board at the project site, indicating that the scheme has been financed by the NEC. The board should also provide information on the date of sanction of the project, cost of the project, date of commencement of the project, date of completion of the project, etc. The same details would also be published in all the documents brought out in this regard.
- 7. The Deputy Commissioner, East Jaintia Hills District, Meghalaya shall get the works duly and properly monitored on monthly/quarterly basis/target as per detailed Action Plan realistically formulated so that there is no scope for time and cost overrun. A completion report should also be submitted after completion of the project.

The project may also be regularly monitored by the Block Level Committee constituted for the project by the Deputy Commissioner East Jaintia District and report has to be submitted to NEC, Shillong.

- 8. The implementing agency i.e., The Deputy Commissioner, East Jaintia Hills District, Meghalaya would submit the detailed monthly and quarterly action plan within one month of the date of issue of this order, which should be within the total duration of the project time line for completion.
- 9. The project should be completed within 2 (two) years from the date of issue of this Administrative Approval.
- 10. The project is sanctioned from 30% component of NEC Outlay in the year 2021-22 and expenditure is debitable to the "Scheme of North Eastern Council" against the following head of account:
