OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Dated Shillong, the 14th March, 2024.

No.PLA.82/2010/27 – The Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to order that henceforth, in supersession of all previous notifications in this regard, the Meghalaya Resource and Employment Generation Council shall stand reconstituted as under and be governed by the following Rules and Regulations:-

1. Constitution :- The Council shall consist of the following members as under:-

(i) Chairman	–	1 (one) No.
(ii) Co-Chairman	–	6 (six) Nos.
(iii) Vice-Chairman/Deputy Chairman	–	10 (ten) Nos.
(iv) Representatives from Respective Department.	–	as required
(v) Non-Official Members	–	5 (five) Nos.
(vi) Member Secretary	–	1 (one) No.

2. Eligibility :-

- (1) Chairman/Co-Chairman :- Sitting member of Meghalaya Legislative Assembly (MLA/Ex-MLA/MDC) or the retired Officers of the All India Services in the Apex Scale, to be nominated by the Chief Minister.
- (2) Vice-Chairman/Deputy Chairman :- MLA/Ex-MLA/Non-MLA
- (3) As (iv) above.
- (4) Non-Official Members :- Ex-MLA/Non-MLA
- (5) Member Secretary :- From the State Civil Service.

3. Tenure :- The term of office will be of 3 (three) years for the Chairman/Co-Chairman/ Vice-Chairman and Deputy Chairman and one year for non official members.

4. Functions :-

1. To commission studies and analyses available data and reports to identify emerging patterns in demand for skills relevant to youth from the State including identification of thrust sectors suited to local context.
2. To identify areas and themes for improving employability potential of youth of the State including, investments in soft skills, languages, grooming etc.
3. To network and interact with Skill Councils, Skill Agencies, Industry Associations, Employers and individual Industries/Companies/Firms for assessing skilled manpower requirements and facilitating investment in the State which generate employment opportunities.
4. To chart out skilling opportunity based on different levels of education attainment of youth, their location (urban or rural), gender and willingness to migrate for employment.
5. To identify supporting infrastructure requirements to the built up or leased by the State or other agencies/employers at locations/clusters across the country where skilled youth from the State can get jobs in significant number.
6. To review current level of use of natural resources including mineral resources and to suggest based on research or stakeholder consultation, measures for adoption of viable technology capable of generating additional employment coupled with skill development programmes in such areas.

7. To examine the existing infrastructure for imparting vocational training and training in various trades and to identify trades which need to be added in view of demands of such skills in the employment market and to recommend measures for providing additional facilities for such training by optimizing/integrating efforts of the Government and other bodies in this regard including potential PPPs and EAPs.
8. To recommend measures to motivate the youth to take up vocational and technical education instead of going exclusively for jobs with Government.
9. To direct conceptualization, design, funding, sanction and implementation of programmes related to enhancement of employability of youth of the State, enhancing employment generation and skill development, where significant gaps in the schemes and programmes offered by other agencies and departments of the Government exist.
10. To review performance of various measures and schemes taken up by the Government for creation of gainful self-employment and placement linked skill development programmes and to suggest measures for sustained growth of employment opportunities.
11. To advise/recommend on all of the above and to go into any other issue which is relevant to the above terms of reference.

The Council may co-opt members or invite experts to its meetings as and when required.
The Council shall submit an Annual Report of activities carried out by it to the Government.
